PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

B7777 is a low viscosity oil based product used to aid the removal and freeing of seized parts with a fast penetrating capillary action, it leaves a clear protective film to guard against further corrosion.

APPLICATIONS

B7777 can be used for the removal and freeing of seized nuts and bolts, hinges, locks, tools and fittings. Suitable for the DIY motorist and also for use on fire arms.

- Low viscosity for maximum penetration
- Easy to apply and works quickly
- Leaves a protective film to guard against corrosion
- Also suitable for light lubrication duties

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Shake can well before use. Spray from 15-30cm on to part allow to penetrate for a few minutes

STORAGE

Storage temperature should be kept below 50°C. Storage area should be out of direct sunlight.
