DESCRIPTION

Bondloc Get a Grip is a high viscosity multipurpose panel adhesive. The high viscosity of this product allows non sagging bonding for light elements.

APPLICATIONS

Bondloc Get a Grip can be used for bonding wooden or rigid PVC skirtings and profiles, polyurethane and polystyrene beams, cornices and slabs, insulating and sound proofing materials.

USEFUL NOTES

- Gap filling up to 12mm
- Can be sanded
- Fast fixing of uPVC frames
- Can be painted
- Forms high strength bonds between most construction materials.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

- Ensure surfaces to be bonded are even, dry and free from dust grease and any other contaminants.
- Cut off tip of cartridge and pierce internal membrane, screw nozzle on to cartridge and cut at a 45° angle to required width. Fit onto a cartridge gun.
- Wet Bonding
- Apply a zigzag bead along the item to be fixed, press firmly into place applying even pressure all over. Unsupported vertical items may require temporary support.
- Allow 24 hours before removing the support.
- On rough and uneven surfaces where gap filling is required apply sufficient adhesive to slightly over fill the gap.
- Contact Bonding
- Heavier items apply a bead as above, press in to place and then pull apart.
 Allow the adhesive to dry for 5 minutes, press firmly into place with even pressure all over.
